

Mason Creek Utility District (the District) is required by the TCEQ to submit quarterly reports showing the average chlorine residuals for the water system and the number of samples taken each month. TCEQ notified the District by mail on October 24, 2017 the reports were not received for the second quarter of this year. The reports were submitted on July 5, 2017 by regular mail. (copy attached) TCEQ has received the first and third quarter reports.

REQUIRED NOTICE

The Mason Creek Utility District water system PWS ID 1010379 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This/these violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period, second quarter, April, May & June of 2017.

No corrective action other than the type of delivery of the reports to TCEQ is required.

The District takes samples from 10 different locations in the District every day to check the chlorine levels in the water. The system is checked daily, including weekends and holidays. The drinking water in Mason Creek Utility District was never at risk for contamination nor was the water system without disinfectant.
